

Hospital Days for the Remainder of the Semester

You will now be assigned clients with needs reflective of the skills you have covered in the campus lab and theory. You will be expected to be able to transfer theoretical concepts into practical application in client care.

If you are meeting the course objectives, you may have opportunity for off-the-floor observational experiences to the OR and RR, as the facility permits. See the instructions on the next page to help you derive maximum benefit from the opportunity. In lieu of completing the “Student Assessment of their Clinical Assignment”, respond in writing to each of the items on the instruction sheet.

Written Assignments: In addition to clinical documentation, the paper work for the remainder of the course includes:

- 1. In addition to the Nutritional Care Plan, Two single diagnoses care plans developed in the Care Plan format. You must complete a client profile for each client. If you develop more than one diagnosis for the client, then the profile need not be redone unless you have additional information to add. Your clinical instructor will give you the due dates for the care plans..**
- 2. “Student Assessment of their Clinical Assignment” for each hospital day except as noted above for the OR/RR days.**
- 3. Other work as assigned by the clinical instructor.**

All written assignments must be accepted as satisfactory in order to successfully meet the course objectives. Turn the work in on time. Revisions may be required to meet objectives.

Final Evaluations: As noted on the calendar, you will meet individually with your clinical instructor to review your performance over the semester. You will receive your grade for the clinical at this time. Each meeting takes approximately 30 minutes.
