

**Math Competency Requirement
Generic Track / LPN-RN Transition Track
All Nursing Courses Except NUR 1020L**

The student will be provided two (2) opportunities to meet the math competency requirement for each subsequent nursing clinic course (except NUR 1020L). A satisfactory score is 90% or higher is required for successful completion on Math Test # 1. Students not obtaining 90% or higher on Math Test # 1 will be required to successfully complete Math Test # 2 with a score of 90% or higher. Medication administration is permitted **only after evidence of 90% or higher on a Math test**. Students not meeting the math competency requirement are **required to withdraw from the nursing clinic course** and shall successfully complete a math remediation course prior to enrolling in another nursing clinic course.

Procedure

1. Math Test #1 will be given within the first week of the term.
2. If the student fails Math Test #1, he/she shall be required to complete required remediation: a) complete math worksheets until 100% competency is achieved and b) complete assigned math problems from Math text, computer program, or CD as directed by the nursing instructor.

Students who do not submit verification of successful completion of the worksheets and assignments, prior to scheduled Math Test # 2 as directed by the nursing instructor is **ineligible** to take Math Test #2 and has not met the math competency requirement. The student who failed Math Test #2, or is ineligible to take Math Test #2 or does not take Math Test #2 as stipulated, has not met the math competency requirement and will be required to **withdraw from the nursing clinic course**.
3. Math Test #2 shall be scheduled one week after Math Test #1. Math test #2 shall **NOT** be given the same day as Math test #1 or the following business day. Medication administration is permitted **only after evidence of 90% or higher** on Math test #2.
4. If the student does not obtain 90% or higher on Math test #2, the student shall be **required to withdraw from the nursing clinic course**. The student shall meet with their Department Head for Nursing to discuss this requirement and the required math remediation course.
5. If the student **fails** Math Test #2 or is ineligible to take Math Test #2 and **withdraws** from the **nursing clinic course**, because of the math competency requirement, the student shall be required to enroll in and successfully complete (90% or higher) a remedial math course offered through the Health Sciences Continuing Education Department. The Department Head for Nursing shall advise the student concerning the appropriate math class required of the student.
 - NUR1211L and NUR2000L math failures will take *Math Review for Nurses CAE 0298*
 - NUR1220L Course and each subsequent nursing course math failures will take *Intermediate Math CAE 0460*
6. Successful completion of the required math course is required to be successfully accomplished **prior** to enrolling in another nursing clinic course.
